#### **Tenancy**

With regards to the allotment tenancy and due to some enquiries about passing on a plot to a relative or friend I feel that it is important to clarify any confusion.

Plots are on a rental basis and no tenant owns or part owns any plot.

The tenancy is renewed annually (rolled over) and needs to be regarded as on an annual rental agreement on behalf of St Andrews allotment association.

If a plot becomes vacant due to the tenant giving up their plot, or through the tenant dying the plot will be reclaimed and become the responsibility of St Andrews allotment association to be re-let.

#### **Considerations**

##### **Family and friend**

We will always consider letting a plot to a family member or friend provided that they have worked with the tenant over a minimum period of 2 years and have put their names onto the waiting list, and if the plot has been cultivated and kept tidy in relation to the tenancy agreement. If any tenant would like in the future to pass on their plot to a member of your family or friend can they inform the Secretary, although a 2 year period is preferable we will consider a family member or friend taking on the plot sooner if through illness or death and the present tenant cannot continue.
