Our grocery members can choose from fresh fruit and veg, bakery items, dairy, eggs, meat or vegetarian protein, store cupboard items, toiletries, pet food and household goods.

We also run give as you can cafes & shops in Harrogate (West Park URC church on a Wednesday) and in Knaresborough (Gracious St Methodist Church on a Friday).
